

## 1) Peel back the fabric to the point where the panel needs to be cut




2) For edge cutouts, if the edges have been hardened, use a hacksaw to cut through the edge hardener




**Exposed**

3) Cut through the balance of fiberglass with a long stainless steel kitchen knife (a bread knife works well)




4) Spray a light mist of adhesive spray (3M 77) on face and around back



(Note: Spray in well ventilated area away from sparks and flame)

5) Crimp the excess fabric (at the corner) in a 45 degree to the corner (tightly) and snip off excess fabric with scissors



(Note: Do Not Overlap Fabric At All)
